# Internship Opportunities for high school music students

Camp Granada internships are available for high school students who participate in band, choir, or orchestra. All internships are volunteer (un-paid). Hours that you serve may be applied to volunteer or community-service requirements of Tri-M, Beta Club, Honor Society, or other school or church-based organizations. For graduating seniors, internship hours may also be applied to TN Promise community service requirements (TN residents only).

Camp Granada is an elementary music day-camp. The weeklong program offers the highest quality music education in a child-centered environment that encourages participation, stimulates creativity and focuses on fun. The Camp Granada curriculum integrates arts and classroom objectives into a music curriculum that fosters creativity and musical exploration. Activities include singing, playing instruments, movement, listening music literacy, and summer-camp style games and activities that continue to expose students to content and skills from the day's lessons. The week concludes with a student performance of the music and skills that have been developed through the week.
