

## **INTERVIEWING TIPS FOR RA CANDIDATES**

- What is your concept of the RA position, and knowledge of job expectations?
- RAs act as referral sources for other residents. How much knowledge of the university do you have?
- What is your attitude toward the RA position, the benefits of residence hall living and trying to help students?
- Why do you feel you would be a good RA? What are your strengths and weaknesses?
- Do you have good communication skills? Explain Why
- Be able to discuss your leadership capabilities

## **OTHER INTERVIEWING TIPS**

- Read the application packet carefully so that you are familiar with the position and requirements.
- Dress neatly and be on time to your interview.
- Be sure to answer all questions with more than just a yes or no. We will ask you to back up your answers.
- Come up with a list of questions that you think might be asked to answer, and have your friend's help you practice.
- Most important: **BE YOURSELF!!!** The purpose of the Interview Process is so you and the Residence Life staff can get to know one another better. It is difficult to that if you are pretending to be someone you are not.
