Counseling Graduate Program SLO Plans 2017-18 Academic Year

The Counseling Graduate Program at Austin Peay State University will focus the Student Learning Outcomes (SLO) for the 2017-2018 academic year on the core counseling content areas of *Ethical Practice*, and *Career Counseling*. Below is a description of the student activities and assessment measures that will be used to assess students' competencies in these two core counseling competencies.

SLO #1: Ethical, Legal & Professional Issues in Counseling

Who	Assessment Measure	Expected Outcome	Assessment Period
First year students	Professional Disclosure Statement and Informed Consent assignment	Obtain a score of 11/14 (79%) or better as measured by assignment rubric.	Fall 2017
Second year students	CPCE Exam <i>Ethical Practice</i> subscale score*	Receive no less than a mean score of 8.91*	Spring 2018

* Students must achieve a score no more than one standard deviation (2.51) below the National mean (11.42) for this subscale (content area).

SLO #2: Theories and Counseling in Career Development

Who	Assessment Measure	Expected Outcome	Assessment Period
First year students	Career Counseling Skills Analysis Paper	Obtain a score of 12/15 (80%) or better as measured by assignment rubric.	Summer 2018
First year students	Career Development Final Exam	Obtain a score of 48/60 (80%) or better on the final exam	Summer 2018
